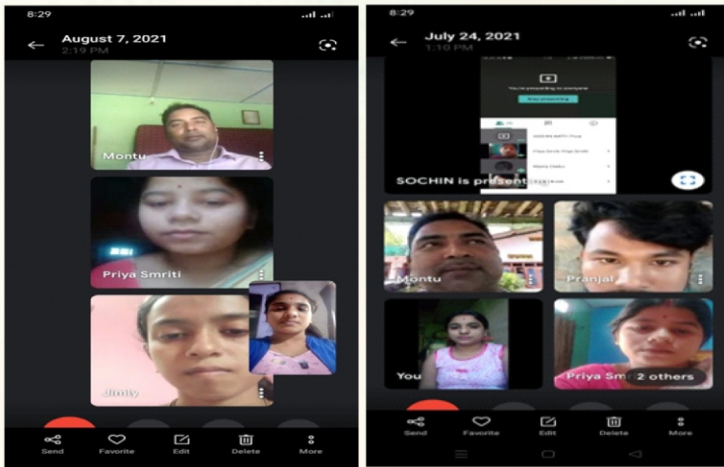
## ONLINE ACTIVITIES
